ALUMNUS ELECTED AS COUNTY MAYOR



Mail pieces must be sent registered mail with a return receipt service. Employees who do not enforce this regulation, risk putting the Postal Service in the uncomfortable position of losing or delaying these items, possibly causing great emotional stress to the family. When mailing cremains, check with your local post office for more information.
